# Support to the Small Business Industrial Base Clothing & Textiles

- **FY17... \$875M total small business contract dollars**

– HUBZone Small Business...	\$175M
– Small Disadvantaged Business...	\$138M
– Women-owned Small Business...	\$133M
– Veteran-owned Small Business...	\$63M



- Small Business suppliers are a vital component of our domestic industrial base.
- **In 2017, over 76% of Clothing & Textiles contract dollars were awarded to domestic small businesses**
- Many small business suppliers met the rapidly escalating demand of many deployments and humanitarian missions.
- Challenge is to maintain industrial base.
