This acquisition will result in the award of approximately seven (7), Firm Fixed Price (FFP), Design-Build (DB) Construction Services Contracts in support of Hurricane Florence Recovery MILCON for Marine Corps Facilities, Primarily Cherry Point and Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. The Government intends to award no more than seven (7) contracts resulting from multiple solicitations to the responsible offerors whose proposals represent the best value after evaluation in accordance with the factors in each solicitation.

Construction projects to be performed under these contracts will primarily consist of general building type projects that are Design-Build (DB). General construction of DB projects include, but are not limited to, new construction, demolition of buildings, systems and infrastructure and may include civil, structural, mechanical, electrical, fire protection, and communication systems. Types of facilities include headquarters, administrative, personnel support, academic, training, vehicle maintenance, warehouses, communications, ranges, etc. in support of Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Mid-Atlantic, Marine Corps Facilities, Primarily Marine Corps Base (MCB) Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point and Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.
