Project Description:

Walbridge Federal is soliciting Subcontractor and Supplier bids from small businesses that can qualify under the SBA guidelines (SB, SDB, WOSB, VOSB, SD-VOSB and Hub-Z) for the construction of three new facilities to include a new AirOps building, Air Traffic Control Tower, and a combined ATC/ATCM & RMD building. Buildings 199, 131, 4327, 1640, 1641, 1790, 144, 146, and 3769 will be demolished to support the consolidation and relocation to new facilities, as well as vacate areas of the flightline that will be needed to support F-35 parking requirements.

Construct a new Air Traffic Control, Air Traffic Control Maintenance (ATC/ATCM) and Range Management Department (RMD) facility adjacent to the new ATCT. This building will be masonry veneered structure with a sloped and gabled standing seam metal roof on a concrete foundation. This building will be a two-story structure and will include administrative and maintenance work spaces for each department or division.

This project will utilize Large Business, Small Business, Veteran-Owned Small Business, Service Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business, HUBZone Small Business, Small Disadvantaged Business, Woman-Owned Small Business, and Historically Black Colleges and Universities/Minority Institutions concerns as subcontractors.
